Bayan Muna and Akbayan lead 17 Party-List groups that may win 23 seats in the House

Social Weather Stations

Seventeen out of 93 party-list groups, lead by BAYAN MUNA and AKBAYAN, meet the minimum 2%-rule for representation in the House of Representatives, in the PDI-SWS Pre-Election Survey of May 2-4, 2007.

The 17 groups satisfying the 2%-rule are: BAYAN MUNA 8.4%, AKBAYAN 8.2%, BUTIL 4.9%, BUHAY 4.2%, GABRIELA 3.9%, A TEACHER 3.6%, AHON 3.5%, CIBAC 3.4%, AANGAT TAYO (AT) 3.0%, AGAP 2.7%, ANAK PAWIS 2.7%, AHONBAYAN 2.6%, COOP-NATCO 2.3%, ABAKADA 2.2%, KABATAAN 2.1%, AMIN 2.1%, and KAKUSA 2.0%.

Possible 23 seats taken

The May 2-4 survey found that 53.0% of the national sample of registered voters chose a party-list representative from the official Comelec list.

Given the latest Comelec count of 45.0 million registered voters, this computes to an estimated 23.9 million votes cast for party-list. This will entitle any party or group receiving at least 2% of the votes for party-list, or at least 480,000 votes, to a party-list seat.

In the party-list system, parties or groups satisfying the 2%-rule will receive one seat for every 2% share in the total votes cast for party-list, subject to another rule that a party or group can only have a maximum of 3 seats.

The survey shows that the 17 qualifying groups are poised to take House 23 seats.

Despite their declining number of votes compared to the SWS April 2007 survey, BAYAN MUNA, now with 8.4% from 10.4% in April, and AKBAYAN, now with 8.2% from 9.8% in April, are still poised to retain their current three seats, which is already the maximum allowed.

BUTIL's votes went to 4.9% in May from 0.7% in April, gaining a chance to add one more to its current seat. BUHAY, with 4.2% of votes, may retain their current two House seats.

GABRIELA (3.9%), CIBAC (3.4%), COOP-NATCCO (2.3%), and AMIN (2.1%) have a chance of keeping their current single seats, while A TEACHER (3.6%), AHON (3.5%), AT (3.0%), AGAP (2.7%), AHONBAYAN (2.6%), ABAKADA (2.2%), KABATAAN (2.1%), and KAKUSA (2.0%) may win one House seat each.

Just below the threshold but within statistical reach are ABANSE! PINAY 1.9%, COCOFED 1.8%, ABONO 1.7%, ASAHAN MO 1.5%, ALAGAD 1.5%, VFP 1.5%, 1-UTAK 1.5%, SUARA 1.5%, ABA-AKO 1.4%, ALMANA 1.3%, APEC 1.3%, ANAK 1.2%, APOI 1.1%, BATAS 1.0%, and ASSALAM 1.0%.

Allowing for sampling error, with a survey outcome of 3.0% or more it is statistically safe to say that a party has truly reached the threshold of 2.0%. On the other hand, a survey outcome of below 1.0% makes it statistically very unlikely that the threshold has in truth been reached.

As of May 2-4, incumbent party-list groups that scored below the statistical threshold were AN WARAY (0.6%), AVE (0.1%), ALIF (0%), and PM (0%).

Party-list votes by area

The party-list groups AKBAYAN, GABRIELA, and AHON met the 2% threshold across all areas.

BAYAN MUNA and KABATAAN satisfied the 2%-rule across all areas except in Mindanao, A TEACHER and AT missed the 2%-threshold only in Metro Manila, while CIBAC missed it in the Visayas.

BUTIL, ANAKPAWIS, and AHONBAYAN drew their support mostly from Balance of Luzon, BUHAY from Metro Manila and Balance Luzon, while AMIN and KAKUSA received most of their votes from Mindanao.

COOP-NATCCO received most of their votes from the Visayas and Mindanao, while ABAKADA from Metro Manila and Mindanao.

Party-list votes by class

The top five party-list groups – BAYAN MUNA, AKBAYAN, BUTIL, BUHAY, and GABRIELA – as well as AHON, ANAKPAWIS, and ABAKADA, satisfied the 2%-rule across all socio-economic classes.

A TEACHER, AT, AHONBAYAN, KABATAAN, and AMIN missed the 2% threshold only among class ABC, while CIBAC, AGAP, and COOP-NATCCO missed it only among class E.

KAKUSA drew much of its support from class E.

Survey background

This special Pre-Election Survey was conducted over May 2-4, 2007, using face-to-face interviews of 1,200 registered voters divided into random samples of 300 each in the four areas of Metro Manila, the Balance of Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. By design, the sample included every city/municipality in Metro Manila, and at least one province in every region in the other three areas. The Balance of Luzon has 6 regions, while Visayas has 3, and Mindanao has 6.

The Commission on Elections counts of Registered Voters, newly released on April 17, 2007, were used to weight regional estimates to obtain area estimates, and to weight area estimates to obtain national estimates.

The 93 names of the party-list groups used in the April survey are as provided by the Commission on Elections.
